

## Summer Internships 2020

The Irish Fiscal Advisory Council is recruiting two summer interns for 2020. The internships will run for up to ten weeks over the summer period, and the specific dates will primarily be based on candidates' availability. The stipend will be €463.54 per week. We will select a panel of candidates for any appointment.

The successful candidates will work on a collaborative project that involves analysing and understanding historical public expenditure in Ireland over a long time horizon. Interns will come away from the project with experience of what it is like to work in a professional organisation developing a large-scale research project.

### Core Requirements:

- strong attention to detail;
- good communication skills;
- a keen interest in economic policy;
- organisational skills including a proven ability to work to deadlines; and
- the ability to work on your own initiative, as well as in a team.
