3. Summer Interns Project

Brian and Gemma, the Summer Interns, joined the meeting to provide an update on their project. The Council reviewed and provided feedback on the analytical note which described the work on a new experimental dataset covering spending related data from the Finance and Appropriation Accounts over the 1922-2018 period.

The changes discussed will be incorporated and circulated to the Council with a view to finalising the analytical note w/c 24 August. Sebastian thanked Brian, Gemma and Killian for their input.

4. Long-Term Sustainability Report – methodology report

The Council reviewed and discussed the draft LTSR methodology report and will provide additional comments with a view to finalising and publishing the report shortly. It was agreed that it would be useful to obtain feedback on the Long-term Sustainability and methodology report in the lead up to the commencement of further research in this area.
