Proceedings

Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

1. Closed Session

The Council discussed the annual Board Self Assessment Evaluation Questionnaires which were returned to the Chairperson.

• The Council **approved the minutes** of the meeting of the Council held on 31st March and 1st April 2021. Adele proposed and Dawn seconded them.

• Items for approval

The Secretariat gave an overview of the draft Annual Report for 2020. The Council approved, subject to some minor amendments, the draft of the Annual Report for submission to the C&AG at audit stage.

Annual review of the effectiveness of internal controls

- (iv) the risk register at each meeting;
- (v) ESRI letter of attestation;
- (vi) the 2020 annual Board Self-Assessment Evaluation Questionnaires; and
- (vii) agreed the 2020 draft Annual Report.

• Standing items:

- Purchases and Receipts book: The Council reviewed the Purchases and Receipts book for March 2021.
- Management Accounts: The management accounts for Q1 (January – March 2021), as reviewed and recommended by the A&RC, were reviewed and approved by the Council.
- Recruitment Update: Interviews with the shortlisted candidates for two positions on the summer internship programme took place in mid-April. Contracts have been exchanged with the two preferred candidates who will commence employment on 31 May for a twelve week period.
- The Council received ten **Parliamentary Questions** since the last meeting.

 FOI Update: The Council received no FOI requests since the last meeting.

Audit and Risk Committee Minutes

Dawn, Chairperson of the A&RC, reported on the meeting held on 21 April 2021.

- Reviewed Management Accounts for Q1 2021;
- Reviewed and provided feedback on the management responses in respect of the OCAG Audit guidance on the impact of Covid-19 on the control environment;
- Reviewed and recommend changes to Section 3 (Financial) of the Risk Register;
- Four policies were reviewed and are recommended to the Council and were agreed and actioned by the Council as follows:

Anti-Fraud Policy – the Council reviewed and agreed the changed policy, updated in respect of cyber financial fraud;

Process for Setting Strategy - the Council reviewed and agreed the unchanged policy;

Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery Plan

 the Council reviewed and agreed the changed policy;

Remote Working Policy – the Council reviewed and agreed the changed policy, updated in respect of internet speed and taxation matters.

- As Mazars has completed its schedule of internal audits, the Council needs to engage in a procurement process for an outsourced internal audit function for a further period. In this regard the A&RC reviewed and recommend to the Council the draft documents for submission to the OGP to

engage in a mini competition in respect of the OGP multi lot framework, lot 3, 'Auditing Services Estimated Contract Value between €25,000 and €144,000'.

- The Council reviewed and agreed with the A&RC's recommendations in respect of updates to Section 3 (Financial) of the **Risk Register** as follows.
 - 3.2 Inadequate Funding expansion of mitigating actions and escalation of likelihood to the highest level;
 - 3.5 Fraud expansion of risk, current controls and change of likelihood level.
- Info Security/GDPR: A number of improvements have been implemented following an analysis of the O365 infrastructure.
