Proceedings

1. Admin/Financial

- **Declarations of interest:**

There were no declarations of interest.

- The Council **approved the minutes** of the meeting of the full session of the Council held on 30th April 2021 and the additional interim meetings regarding the FAR on 10, 11 & 27 May 2021. Dawn proposed and Michael seconded them.

- **Matters arising**

There were no matters arising.

- **Draft Communications Strategy**

The Council discussed its longer-term Communication Strategy, which it will review every three years, and its annual Communication Plan which it will set and review

annually. It was agreed to add Communications as a standing item on the agenda.

- **Items for approval**

- Procurement – Software

The Council reviewed and agreed with the proposal outlining the rationale and costings in respect of a proposed switch to Macrobond an enhanced and more efficient software option to provide rapid access to data and to enable a more streamlined updating of large datasets in respect of the endorsement and other work. Based on comparable costings of two user licences of similar products, Macrobond is the most economically advantageous and they are amenable to providing immediate ongoing access whilst the Council's contract with its current provider Refinitiv in respect of Datastream concludes in December 2021.

- Procurement – Internal Audit Services

The OGP mini competition in respect of the outsourcing of internal audit services closed on 3 June 2021. This competition was advertised by the OGP to framework members. The tender evaluation report outlined the review of the one tender received and the outcome of the process. The Council approved the winning tender and subject to the recommendation of the A&RC, who meet on the 14 July, will review a draft contract at its next meeting to engage Mazars to provide internal audit services for a fixed price of €8,125 ex VAT for a 48mth period.

- The **Council Member's Fees and Time Buyouts** for the period January – June 2021, as set out in letters of appointment (and approvals set by Department of Public Expenditure and Reform), were reviewed and approved.

- **Standing items:**
 - **Purchases and Receipts book:** The Council reviewed the Purchases and Receipts book for April and May 2021.
 - **Management Accounts:** The management accounts for Q2 2021 will be available in mid-July.
 - **Recruitment Update:** Allan Kelly and Ksenija Semiskura joined the Secretariat on the summer internship programme on 31 May for a period of 12 weeks.

- Summer Interns project

Allan and Ksenija gave a presentation on the summer intern project - mapping the public sector - which aims to provide a better understand of the spending by government bodies.

- Fiscal Space Calculator

The Council reviewed and provided feedback on the Fiscal Space Calculator with a view to releasing the tool to the website shortly. This is an interactive tool that lets users to explore alternative budgetary choices for the coming years.

The Council noted the Secretariat's other ongoing work to include – Health Analytical Note; Fiscal Limits paper; Output gap working group papers; Analytical note on climate change; Long-term papers seminar; and Fiscal Monitor dashboard.
