- 1. Admin/Financial

It was confirmed that the additional information, sought by the Department in respect of the implementation of the OECD recommendations, regarding staffing grades and resourcing the position of chair on an up to half time basis has been provided. The Department has advised that the upcoming Public Appointment Service (PAS) State Board's Competition will mirror previous campaigns for Council Members (including a Chairperson) at the usual standard rate of remuneration. In this regard the Department prepared drafts of the PAS Information booklet and State Boards Vacancy Notice, for review and feedback, for a competition to fill the current vacancy of Chairperson, and any further vacancy[ies] for Ordinary Member's on the Council which may arise in 2023/2025. The Council will again indicate a strong preference for advertising the position of Chairperson separately and on an up to half time basis.
