- 1. The Admin/Financial
- Declarations of interest:

There were no declarations of interest

• Update on OECD recommendations

Legislation is progressing in respect of proposed amendments to the Fiscal Responsibility Act which are being incorporated into the Finance (Tax Appeals and Fiscal Responsibility) Bill.

• Council appointments

It was noted that Adele Bergin was re-appointed as a Council Member for a second 4-year term effective 1 January 2025 It was noted that Alessandro Giustiniani was re-appointed as a Council Member for a second 4-year term effective 1 January 2025.

In this regard, the Terms of Reference of the A&RC will also be updated to reflect both re-appointees extending their most recent A&RC membership to the full three-year period.

• For approval

The **Council Member's Fees and Time Buyouts** for the period July – December 2024, as set out in letters of appointment (and approvals set by Department of Public Expenditure and Reform), were reviewed and Approved.

The Council agreed to a further one year extension of the Framework and Services Contract with the Public Authority Pension Services (**PAPS**).

• SSA 2025

The ESRI provides office accommodation and building services on a pro rata basis and support services relating primarily to accounts, IT, and other corporate services. The Council reviewed and agreed for signature the 2025 Shared Services Agreement (SSA) with the ESRI, covering the period 1 January to 31 December 2025.

In addition, management performed a SSA benchmarking exercise, as per an internal audit recommendation that this be conducted every 4/5 years to determine whether value for money is realised, it was confirmed that the results suggest that the ESRI remains a costeffective provider.

• Climate Action Mandate

The Council reviewed, discussed and provided feedback on the draft of the updated Climate Action Roadmap in respect of the Irish Climate Action Mandate (CAM). Returns in respect of SEAI M&R and CAM have been submitted. In addition, the Council has achieved NTA smarter travel mark silver certification.
